CITY OF OAKLAND-BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING

APPROVAL OF THE MARCH MINUTES was tabled until May.

REVIEW OF TREASURER'S REPORT AND APPROVAL OF EXPENSES The financial statements for the month were reviewed, noting that the payroll had been reviewed and approved by the Treasurer. The City Attorney and Treasurer explained current approved uses of ARPA funds under \$10M, including police and fire services, construction and/or street and stormwater improvements. The Board voted 3-0 in favor of approving the voucher.
